POULTON METHODIST CHURCH CHARITY SHOP

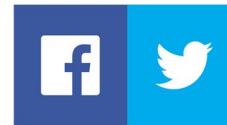

HARVEST FESTIVAL

Locally we are being asked to support Streetlife a young people's homeless shelter in Blackpool, they need tinned foods and toiletries and also Comfort Zone in Blackpool who prefer tins and packets of food.

Internationally Lancashire Methodist District have a project in Sierra Leone which a team are visiting in November, they have a hospital that requires paracetamol and a training centre with a Tailoring workshop requiring Sewing machine needles, bobbins of cotton, exercise books, tape measures (the cloth type for dress making) scissors, and a carpentry workshop needing pencils, tape measures. Streetlife and Comfort Zone is ongoing and items for Sierra Leone can be given until later this month. If you prefer monetary donations can also be given to these projects.
